Agility Event Classes
(Dogs must be 12 months or older)

Regular Classes: Regular classes will be offered for any Cavalier jumping in its required height division according to AKC regulations. At trials held on consecutive days, a Cavalier entered in at least one Regular class may not be entered in any Preferred class.

Regular Standard Classes

Novice A: Dogs not holding any agility title in any registry, shown by a handler who has not completed any agility title with a Cavalier or a dog of any other breed in any country in which the breed is recognized.

Novice B: Any dog not holding a C-NA may compete in this class.

Open: Any dog not holding a C-OA title.

Excellent A: Any dog not holding a C-AX title.

Excellent B: Dogs holding a C-AX title or an AKC AX title.

Regular Jumper Classes

Novice A: Dogs not holding any agility title in any registry, shown by a handler who has not completed any agility title with a Cavalier or a dog of any other breed in any country in which the breed is recognized.

Novice B: Any dog not holding a C-NAJ may compete in this class.

Open: Any dog not holding a C-OAJ title.

Excellent A: Any dog not holding a C-AXJ title.

Excellent B: Dogs holding a C-AXJ title or an AKC AXJ title.

Preferred Classes: Preferred classes will be offered for any Cavaliers jumping one height division lower than its required height division according to AKC regulations. At trials held on consecutive days, a Cavalier entered in at least one Preferred class may not be entered in any Regular class. An additional 5 seconds will be added to the standard course time for all preferred classes.

Preferred Standard Classes

Novice A: Dogs not holding any agility title in any registry, shown by a handler who has not completed any agility title with a Cavalier or a dog of any other breed in any country in which the breed is recognized.

Novice B: Any dog not holding a C-NAP may compete in this class.

Open: Any dog not holding a C-OAP title.

Excellent A: Any dog not holding a C-AXP title.

Excellent B: Dogs holding a C-AXP title or an AKC AXP title.

Preferred Jumper Classes

Novice A: Dogs not holding any agility title in any registry, shown by a handler who has not completed any agility title with a Cavalier or a dog of any other breed in any country in which the breed is recognized.

Novice B: Any dog not holding a C-NJP may compete in this class.

Open: Any dog not holding a C-OJP title.

Excellent A: Any dog not holding a C-AJP title.

Excellent B: Dogs holding a C-AJP title or an AKC AJP title.

Agility Trial Regulations

The Regulations for Agility Trials of the American Kennel Club (AKC) will be imposed for all CKCSC-USA agility trials, with the following exceptions:

1. All agility classes will have nested courses (this will eliminate course building for each level).
2. Courses will be designed except for the following weave pole exceptions;

| Weave Poles | Novice | Open | Excellent |
|--------------------|---------------|-------------|------------------|
| Standard | 0 | 6 | 12 |
| Jumpers | 6 | 12 | 12 |

3. A jump height card indicating the height of the dog at the withers issued by an agility organization must be attached to the trial entry form. If a dog does not have a jump height card, the dog must be measured by an official judge before the start of the class.
4. The jump height divisions of the AKC will be followed.
5. Move-ups must be presented to the show secretary 30-minutes before start of trial.
6. Exhibitors may enter a dog in a higher performance class to earn the higher title, but the class may not change after the closing date of the trial.

7. Performance qualifications;

To earn a title, A Cavalier may earn more than one qualifying score under the same judge; but at least two of those qualifying scores must have been earned from at least two different judges.

Preferred titles: The above regular titles followed by a 'P' will be identified as Preferred titles (C-NAP, etc).

Cavalier Preferred Agility Excellent (C-PAX)

This title will be awarded to any Cavalier who has earned six double qualifying scores at the preferred jump height. A double qualifying score is earned when the dog qualifies in both the Standard Excellent B Preferred class and the Jumper Excellent B Preferred class at the same trial.

Cavalier Master Agility Champion (C-MACH)

This title will be awarded to any Cavalier who has earned the **Cavalier Grand Agility Master award** three times and has earned a minimum of six double qualifying scores. A double qualifying score is earned when the dog qualifies in both the Standard Excellent B Regular class and the Jumper Excellent B Regular class at the same trial. This title supersedes all Regular agility titles. Since this title is the highest agility titles a cavalier can earn, demonstrating superior performance, this title will precede the dog's registered name.

Cavalier Grand Agility Master (C-GAM) *annual agility award*

This Award Certificate will be issued to the top five-ranked Cavaliers exhibiting in any Excellent B class at Regular jump height. Preferred classes are not eligible for the Cavalier Grand Agility Master award. Ranking will be the total of the following from all CKCSC-USA agility trials held within a calendar year:

- Total course points. Course points are awarded for each full second under standard course time. No partial points are awarded.
- Dogs placing first in their class double their course points.
- Dogs placing second in their class receive one and one-half times their course points. All fractions are rounded down.
- Ten points are awarded for each double qualifying score. A double qualifying score is earned when the dog qualifies in both the Standard Excellent B class and the Jumpers Excellent B class at the same trial.

From NJ Turnpike exit 7A:

Take I-195 East to Route 526.

Make a Right on Route 526 to Main Street.

Make a Right on Main St. to Route 539.

Make a Left on Route 539 to Hornerstown-Arneytown Road.

Make a Right on Hornerstown-Arneytown Road.

From NJ Turnpike exit 7:

Take Route 206 North to Route 528 (Crosswicks Road).

Make a Right on Route 528; travel approximately 6 miles until Route 528 turns right.

DO NOT TURN RIGHT - GO STRAIGHT (Road is now Route 664).

Follow Route 664; it will turn right; Turn Right to stay on Route 664

Arneytown-Hornerstown Road is approximately 2 miles on your left.
